Prof. Bambang Susantono is an internationally recognized technocrat and development professional with over 30 years of experience in infrastructure, urban planning, and sustainable development. From 2015 to 2022, he served as Vice-President of the Asian Development Bank (ADB) for Knowledge Management and Sustainable Development, where he oversaw departments covering sustainable development and climate change, economic research and regional cooperation, and external relations.

In Indonesia, Prof. Bambang has held several ministerial-level roles, including Deputy Minister for Infrastructure and Regional Development at the Coordinating Ministry for Economic Affairs, Vice Minister of Transportation, and most recently, the Presidential Envoy for International Cooperation in the Development of Indonesia's new capital (IKN Nusantara) and the Head of the IKN Authority (2022–2024).

He is active globally as Special Advisor to UCLG ASPAC and the High-Level Panel on Water and Disasters, Board Member of the Islamic Development Bank Institute, and a member of the Bloomberg New Economy Council for Cities. He holds a PhD in Infrastructure Planning and two master's degrees from the University of California, Berkeley, and an honorary professorship in Livable and Sustainable Cities from Diponegoro University.
