

Mr. Hirotaka Yamauchi, President, Japan Transport and Tourism Research Institute

After serving as a full-time instructor for the Faculties of Commerce and the Faculty of Economy, Chukyo University, Mr. Hirotaka Yamauchi became a full-time instructor at the Faculty of Commerce and Management, Hitotsubashi University in 1991. In 2000, he took the position of professor at the Graduate School of Commerce, Hitotsubashi University and is specially appointed professor, Graduate School of Business Administration at present.

While pursuing his career as Professor, he dedicated himself to the overseas research activities at Robert H. Smith School of Business at the University of Maryland in USA from 2001 to 2002. He served as Dean of Graduate School of Commerce and Faculty of Commerce and Management, Hitotsubashi University from 2005 to 2008. He is involved in the examination of the issues concerning the participation of the private sector in the construction of the infrastructure and the fund raising, as well as the cost burden, the theoretical verification and practical research of the methods such as PFI/PPP.
