He also serves as the President of ISCEA Indonesia and previously held the position of Dean of the School of Interdisciplinary Management and Technology (SIMT) ITS for the 2021–2024 period.

Prof. Pujawan is widely recognized as one of Indonesia's leading experts in supply chain management and logistics. Since 2001, he has delivered more than 200 training programs, workshops, and capacity-building initiatives in the fields of supply chain management, logistics, operations management, and industrial systems for various government institutions and private-sector organizations.

In the areas of academia and research, he has published more than 60 articles in reputable international journals and has actively participated as a speaker at numerous national and international forums. In recognition of his contributions to science and research, he has also been listed among the Top 2% World Scientists published by Stanford University in collaboration with Elsevier.

In addition to his academic activities, Prof. Pujawan has extensive experience as a consultant in strategic projects related to logistics, supply chains, and industrial systems, having been involved in more than 45 consultancy projects for both public and private sectors.
