- 2. To analyze the collected information, identify issues, and study specific measures to solve the issues, which are supported by the academic and business knowledge in the field of transport and tourism in Japan.
- 3. To Disseminate and provide information on the results of research survey, including policy proposals, to a wide range of stakeholders in this area and in Japan through the distribution and publication of reports and the holding of seminars and symposiums.
- 4. To build an organizational and human network
