Mr. Suzuki graduated from Waseda University in 1975 and joined Jiji Press, a Japanese news agency. He served as a political writer and was assigned to the agency's Washington Bureau as a Staff Correspondent (1990-1994). He also served as President of Jiji Press America Inc. and the agency's New York Bureau Chief (2001-2005). From 2012 to 2015, he worked concurrently as Senior Commentator and Editor-in-Chief of Diplomacy Magazine 'Gaiko'. He then became Senior Research Fellow for the Foreign Service Training Institute (2018-2020) and a member of The Management Advisory and Evaluation Committee, Japan Bank for International Cooperation, JBIC (2011-2021). He currently serves as a Visiting Fellow at the Fujitsu Future Studies Center Ltd. and as a Visiting Fellow at the Jiji Research Institute. His major publications include Japan's Strategic Diplomacy (Chikuma Shinsho 2017, in Japanese) and Negotiation History of the Northern Territories (Chikuma Shinsho 2021, in Japanese).
