Hirotaka Yamauchi was born in 1955 in Narita City, Chiba Prefecture. He completed his doctorate program in the Graduate School of Commerce at Keio University.

After serving as a full-time lecturer at Chukyo University, he became a Professor of the the Graduate School of Commerce at Hitotsubashi University. From 2006 to 2010 he was the Dean of that Graduate School. He is currently the President of the Japan Transport and Tourism Research Institute (JTTRI) and is also a specially appointed professor of the Graduate School of Business Administration at Hitotsubashi University.

He has served as a member of the PFI Promotion Committee of the Cabinet Office, a member of the Transport Policy Council of the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism, a member of the Social Infrastructure Development Council, and a member of the Financial System Council of the Ministry of Finance.

Currently, he is a member of the Advisory Committee for Natural Resources and Energy of the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry, and a member of the Information and Communications Council of the Ministry of International Affairs and Communications.
