




"Tourism is the main bridge for building understanding. It has a unique ability to promote peace between and among peoples everywhere." (2022, UNWTO)

History of Tourism between the US and Japan



1854: 170 years of exchange since the signing of the U.S.-Japan Treaty of Peace and Amity

1952: JNTO opened New York office as the first overseas office

2019: Number of visitors from the U.S. to Japan hit 1.7 million, the largest of long-haul markets

2020: Covid-19 Pandemic


February 2023: Number of U.S. visitors to Japan recovered up to 94% of max figure in 2019 before pandemic

Attended by an estimated 700-800 tour operators, destination representatives, adventure travel writers, and thought leaders from across 60 countries

What is ATTA?

- Abbreviation for Adventure Travel Trade Association.
- The largest organization in adventure tourism industry since 1990, headquartered in Seattle.
- Consists of 1,300 members from 100 countries, including media, NTOs, tourism associations, DMOs, tour operators and outdoor manufacturers.







Ozu Castle Stay (Ehime)

- Japan's first accommodation in a wooden castle tower.
- Visitors participate in the traditional performing arts of gagaku and kagura and enjoy locally grown food.



Overnight at Ninnaji Temple (Kyoto)

- Stay overnight in a world cultural heritage site with a history of 1100 years.
