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After he graduated from the Department of Civil Engineering, The University of Tokyo, he was a research associate at the University of Tokyo until 2002. He worked as a researcher at the National Institute for Land and Infrastructure Management, Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism, Japan for 15 years, including a temporary assignment as chief researcher of the Overseas Coastal Area Development Institute of Japan (2012-2015), visiting researcher of Modern Logistics Research Center, Tsinghua University (2006-2007), and visiting Associate Professor of Kyoto University (2014-2017).

His research focus is primarily on global intermodal freight flow modeling, port logistics, and maritime big data analysis.
